Registrations

• Required documents	Registration form
• Registration deadline	Early registration (at least 2 months prior) recommended and preferred, as first come, first serve, but no strict deadline as such. Registrations possible as long as seats are available, but please be aware of the time you need for travel and visa arrangements.
• Selection/Prerequisites	First Degree, work experience, course expectation. For some courses specific experience is recommended, but not mandatory. No selection date (first come, first serve)
• Procedure	After the registration is approved, the confirmation letter including the invoice is sent out.
• Note	Several courses part of Heidelberg postgraduate MScIH, thus limited seat availability

Course Fee

• General Admittance	EUR 1.500-; 1 week courses EUR 750,-
• topEd students	EUR 1.000, selected courses EUR 750,- 1 week courses EUR 500,-
• Included in Fee	Course material, 2 coffee breaks/day
• Payment	Usually by bank transfer (preferred); check payment possible. No credit card transfer possible. Confirmation of the payment needs to be sent as a scan or copy to the institute
• Cancellation Fee	Applies, details on registration form and with invoice

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Generally required information by embassies 	<p>Return flight, accommodation confirmation, confirmation/invitation letter from Heidelberg, health insurance for Germany, Please note: some German embassies accept scanned invitation letters, other require an original letter Requirements vary greatly between country offices!!</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Time for application 	Varies greatly! From 1 to 8 weeks or more

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If needed by participant 	<p>Please note, we send out an invitation letter only after we have received the full course fee on our account. Exceptions may apply only to former participants, tropEd students or participants send by trusted partners / organisations</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Full / part time 	Full Time
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Level 	Postgraduate, Advanced Level
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact h / self study h proportion in general 	~80% contact / 20% self study time
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lecturers 	Usually a mixture of institutional staff and external lecturers (NGOs, GO's (GIZ; WHO, etc), from other (partly intern.) universities, intern. Consultants, etc.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants 	tropEd students, MSciH students Heidelberg, (both postgraduate), individual participants Group composition varies between courses
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Example general course structure: 	2 weeks, Mo-Fri, 9am- 5pm, 90h SIT, 3 ECTS (tropEd)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Public Holidays 	In general, there will be class on public holidays

Courses Venue	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Location 	<p>On Campus "Im Neuenheimer Feld". Detailed information is send out prior to course</p> <p>Heidelberg is a relative small town, the city centre is reachable quickly by bus or tram</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Note 	<p>Courses run in cooperation with evaplan and Inwent ("Economic Principles of Social Security", "Macro Political Aspects of Social Security" and "Financial Controlling and Management") take place at Inwent training centres (either Mannheim or Berlin)</p>
Certificates	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Certificate of Attendance 	<p>Given at the end of the course for every successful participant, stating duration and content</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> tropEd Grade Report: 	<p>tropEd students receive in addition a grade report.</p> <p>The original is send to the respective home institution, the student receives a copy.</p> <p>Given out once assessment is marked.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Note 	<p>Non-tropEd students may get a grade report if requested in time.</p>
Accommodation	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Arranged?! Self?! On campus?! 	<p>Accommodation needs to be arranged by participants themselves.</p> <p>Information on different kinds of accommodation with contact details is send out together with the invoice.</p> <p>On campus accommodation may be possible during semester breaks (contacts on the list)</p> <p>Companies who arrange accommodation can be found on the list as well.</p>
Computer / Internet Access	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Computers available for course work 	<p>Several computer rooms with internet on university campus</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Internet access 	<p>Several computer rooms with internet on university campus</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wireless LAN access 	<p>Possible at course venue and on campus at diverse locations.</p>
On campus	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Facilities on campus 	<p>Bank, small bookshop, copy shop, computer room,...</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Food 	<p>Student Cafeteria (so called Campus Card needed, see Campus Card)); Cafes, bakery, small supermarket, small restaurants</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Registration with university directly 	<p>Neither necessary, nor possible</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Library access: how? 	<p>Small library in Institute with lending possibility; Access to University Library, books available for copying, but not for taking out (only for students registered at HD)</p>

Campus Card	
• Deposit	5 EUR to be paid to Student information centre
• Upload	At machines in student cafeteria
• Payments possible	student cafeteria, Cafe Botanik, copy machines in INF 305, etc
• Return	To the same place, deposit and money left on card are returned
• Note	At the student cafeteria payment only with campus card possible

Estimated Living costs
