

The 3rd Heidelberg QI Forum will be taking place from 15 - 16 June 2017 in Heidelberg.

The Forum is jointly organised by evaplan International Health at the University Hospital Heidelberg, the AQUA Institute, Göttingen, the Institute of Public Health, Heidelberg University, and The International Society for Quality in Health Care, ISQua.

This year's Forum discusses "How to fit patient Safety into QI mechanisms?" with a focus on Quality Improvement mechanisms in Low and Middle Income Countries. The Forum aims to determine if these mechanisms reflect Patient Safety issues, if there is a demand in formulating and reformulating certain standards to actually reflect these issues, address the challenges of using Patient Safety data for health system strengthening and, finally, explore hidden Patient Safety issues related to culture, gender, ethnicity and marginalisation.
